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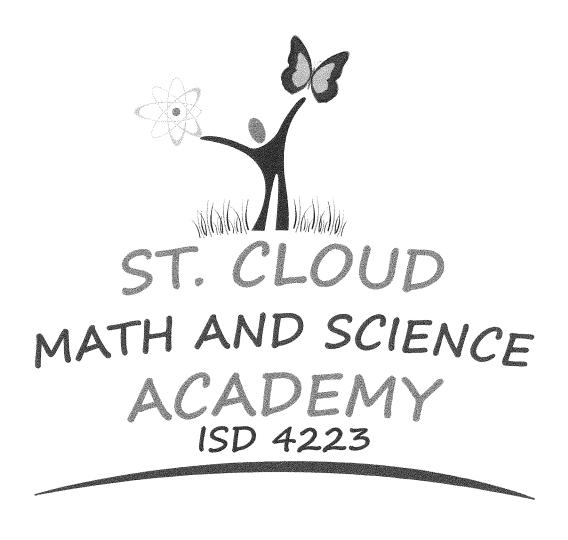

- * The School's original budget projects a net surplus for the year of \$199,358. A projected cumulative fund balance of \$2,029,841 or 32% of expenditures at fiscal year-end.

Financial Statement Key Points

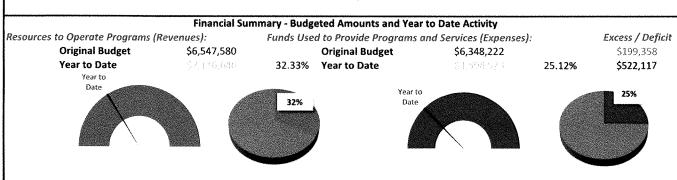
- * As of month-end, 33.3% of the year was complete.
- * Cash Balance as of the reporting period is \$1,950,475, down slightly from \$1,975,860 the previous month.
- * Current year holdback estimated balance is \$272,411 as of the reporting period. The holdback amount is approximately 10% of total state aids. The remaining holdback amount will be paid back to the school in fiscal year 2026.

- * Expenditures disbursed at end of the reporting period -25.1%

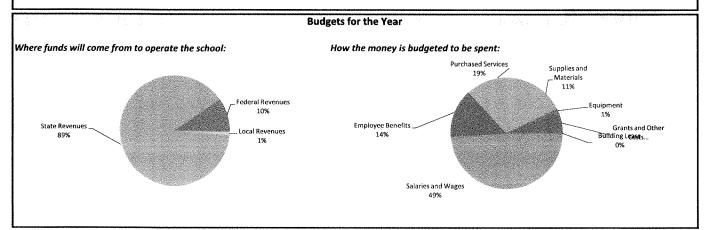

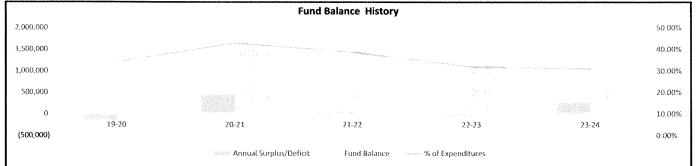
- * Received portion of Read Act funding \$11,720; will work with leadership on how to use these funds.

- * Food Service fund is not showing any federal or state revenue. Recommend submitting clics counts to MDE to get revenue flowing.

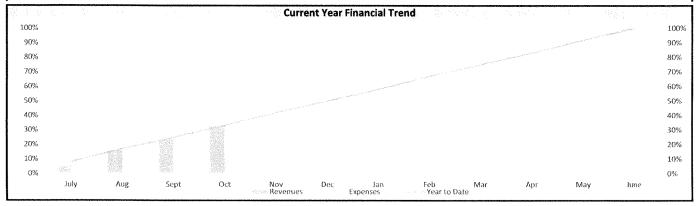
